- Type www.baileybridge.net into the address bar
- Enter the Geography Bridge part of the website
- Work your way through the blue project



Your task is to make a large presentation using ICT or paper about India.

It should contain:

- pictures
- tables
- text
- diagrams
- maps

The presentation will need to show information about

1) Location

- where India's main cities are
- how large are the cities in terms of population

2) Population

- description of population
- factors affecting population e.g. birth and death rates
- types of migration
- causes of migration
- urban and rural
- population distribution
- population pyramids
- description of India's population and how it has changed over the years.

3) Climate

- weather and climate
- factors affecting climate
- how the climate varies between cities in India



4) Physical

- landscape
- variations between north and south
- variations between coastal and inland areas
- rivers

5) Life in India

- people
- buildings
- transport
- work
- stalls
- clothes
